



Dress Code

Our dress code promotes a respectful and academic minded Torah environment. We reserve the right to deem an article of clothing or mode of dress as inappropriate for the yeshiva.

GRADES 1 THROUGH 8:

SHIRTS: A three-button polo shirt with a collar or a full button-down shirt with the collar is acceptable in grades 1-5.

Complete button-down shirts (no polos) are required for grades 6-8.

PANTS: Traditional loose-fitting pants or slacks. Cargo pants, jeans, tiros or sweatpants maybe not worn.

SHOES: Sneakers or rubber-soled shoes. Rubber soles are a must for the safety of the student if he does not have sneakers for gym. Slippers, Crocks, slides, etc. not permitted.

YARMULKES: Without secular themes or logos.
