Carpool Instructions

- Arrival begins through the back door
- Enter the parking lot on Serena Road and follow the traffic flow to the Moros.
- Please unbuckle and take your child out of the car. Bring them to the Morah at the back doors.
- The Moros will bring your son inside.
- Please do not let your child out of the car until you are the 1st or 2nd car.
- When exiting your car, you MUST shut off your car (and take your keys).
- At dismissal, a teacher will bring your child to your car. Parents please seat your child in the car.
