When the advertising began for the great MetLife siyum last summer, our Rosh Yeshiva, Rabbi

Kamenetzky received a call from his son Zvi, a YOSS alumnus, then a distinguished talmid in Yeshiva Torah Temima. He asked if a Mr. Arthur Shield was still teaching American history at the Yeshiva.

"Of course he is! He is the best! We would not let him leave!" said Rabbi Kamenetzky.

Zvi asked his father if he could arrange that he get a ticket together with Mr. Shield for the siyum. "Mr. Shield? Siyum HaShas? Why"



This year at the 56th Annual Banquet, the Yeshiva we will be paying a special tribute to Rabbi Chaim Krieger on the occasion of his Aliyah to Eretz Yisroel where he plans to continue to teach Torah. For nearly four decades, Rabbi Chaim Krieger has infused his class with a unique warmth and style that combines the ruach of yesteryear with the



skills needed to become true Torah scholars. A master teacher, Rabbi Krieger has imparted his Chassidic heritage through *Modzitz zemiros* and stories of *gedolim*, and has helped the boys become true B'nei Torah. Over the years he has taught the skills and the texts to our

6th graders enabling their mastery over large portions of *Mesechtas Sukkah*, and *Sefer Bamidbar*, and many of the Mishnayos that deal with *Mitzvos Hat'luyos B'Aretz* - the laws pertaining to the growth of crops and the cultivation of the Land of Israel, including *Peah*, *D'mai* and *Shviis*. Rabbi Krieger has just recently published an illustrated *sefer* in English that actually details many of the *halachos* that are entailed in those *Mishnayos*.

How fitting is it that he will continue to teach Torah in our beloved Land of Israel.
