



DRESS CODE

Our dress code promotes a respectful and academic minded Torah environment.

SHIRTS:

Grades 1-5: A three-button polo shirt with a collar or a full button-down shirt with a collar

Grades 6-8: Full button-down shirts with a collar (no polos)

PANTS:

Traditional loose-fitting pants or slacks. Cargo pants, jeans, tiros, sports-pants or sweatpants may not be worn.

SHOES:

Sneakers or rubber-soled shoes. Slippers, Crocks, slides, etc. may not be worn.

YARMULKA & TZITZIS:

Yarmulka and tzitzis are expected to be worn at all times. (We have a stock in the office available for purchase in case they get lost or dirty.)

HAIRCUTS:

Haircuts should reflect the yeshiva's environment and not mimic pop-culture styles or trends.
